In-Person Services

As you read the specifics, please keep in mind that these plans will constantly be evaluated and adjusted in the weeks ahead as the Lord leads through conviction and circumstance. If you have any uneasiness about attending after reading this plan, please continue to enjoy the services offered online. For clarity and expediency, these will be presented as bullet points. Hospitality

- 9:30 am Traditional Service
- 11:00 am Contemporary Service
- No bulletins will be passed out.
- Donuts and coffee will be served by a volunteer.
- Sealed communion cups are available just outside the worship center to pick up as you enter the worship center. (Trash cans are there to dispose of cups after service.)
- An offering box is in the lobby as well if you want to worship through giving by bringing your tithe with you. Offering boxes are also available at the north and south doors in the back of the worship center.
- Bibles and hymnals are also available there to pick up if you desire to have one. (Please leave them at your seat when you leave and they will be cleaned before they are returned.)
- Masks are recommended, but not mandatory.
- Please respect each others' space by practicing as much social distancing as possible.
- Services will be approximately 55 minutes long in order to allow plenty of time to clean.

Children's Ministry

- We will provide in-person kids' programming only during the 11:00 am service for nursery through 6th grade.
- We will check temperatures before allowing anyone to enter the children's area.
- All teachers and volunteers will wear masks during the entire service.
- We will attempt to enforce social distancing but cannot guarantee that it will be adhered to by the kids.
- Entire area will be cleaned prior to the worship service.
- Hand sanitizer is available at all locations for students and volunteers.
- Pre-K kids will check in as usual and go to their classroom and will stay there the entire service.
- Kindergarten and above will check in as usual and proceed to the large group area where seats will be socially distanced.
- Kids will be divided into groups and will travel to stations set up at various locations: Lesson, Craft, Game, Snack.
- Kids will finish in the large group area for worship in song and the taking of communion (sealed cups will be used). Parents will pick them up here.

Teens

- All of the chairs in the classrooms will be spaced apart.
- If needed, we will add additional classroom space.
- Weather permitting, we will go outside for class.
